Can you please discuss the assumption.</p> <p>2. Nov 26 08 school projection enrollment What happens between 2016 and 2018 in the St Rene Academy catchment area that results in an additional 20 children in the school, based on guidelines for projections that could be (1 catholic school student for 28 homes) 500 new homes or several larger families? Can you please discuss the assumption.</p> <p>I understand these are not scientific and cannot be relied up based on the notes but what drives these two years to result in such a large bump?"</p>	<p><i>There is currently an unusually small Senior Kindergarten class size of 16, which will graduate in 2016. Projections indicate that this will not be the trend moving forward. The Senior Kindergarten classes are projected to be larger, and this will cumulatively result in an increase once the small 2008 SK class graduates. There is also a development component to the projections.</i></p> <p><i>The enrolment projection for St. René-Goupil-St. Luke between 2016-2018 is starting to show the cumulative and continuing effect of the Leitchcroft development located between Hwy 7, Hwy 407, Leslie and Bayview.</i></p>
