3) SPECIFIC STATEMENT OF ISSUE:

Parents of St. Brendan CES have identified gaps in the Board's policy on the selection and implementation of 'Before and After Care' programs operating in our schools. Issues of concern relate to (1) quality of care and program (2) fees paid by parents (3) automatic renewal of lease permits (4) lack of protocol to escalate issues relating to the conduct of an operator. Our primary concerns relate the imperative to implement a transparent and accountable process for B&A operators providing childcare services in our schools.
