Dear Parents and Guardians,

RE: Revisions to the Health & Physical Education Curriculum – Secondary Schools

We are writing to you today regarding the recent release of the Ministry of Education's revised Health and Physical Education (HPE) Curriculum.

We understand and respect that parents and guardians are the primary educators of their children. Your role in the teaching of family life issues is vital. As a Catholic school system, we work with our parents and our parishes to provide for our students an education that is founded in the Gospel of Jesus, and reflects a Catholic worldview.

While we have a responsibility to teach the curriculum set out by the Ministry of Education in education policy, we have always done so in a manner that conveys, respects and models our Catholic values to our students.

For more than 30 years, our schools, and all Catholic schools in Ontario, have successfully provided a Family Life Curriculum within a Catholic framework under the guidance of the Catholic Bishops of Ontario. In Secondary Religious Education, the Family Life strand is included in all religious education courses. Both the Family Life strand of Religious Education and the curriculum in Health and Physical Education are delivered with an approach that ensures that themes are taught in light of our Catholic faith and the teachings of the Church.

Although the revised curriculum has been released, it will not be introduced to students until September 2015. The Catholic education community of Ontario will work together to produce resources that support our Catholic teachers and ensure that the curriculum delivered in our classrooms is consistent with our Catholic teachings, and appropriate within the context of a Catholic classroom. The Institute for Catholic Education will coordinate this work.
