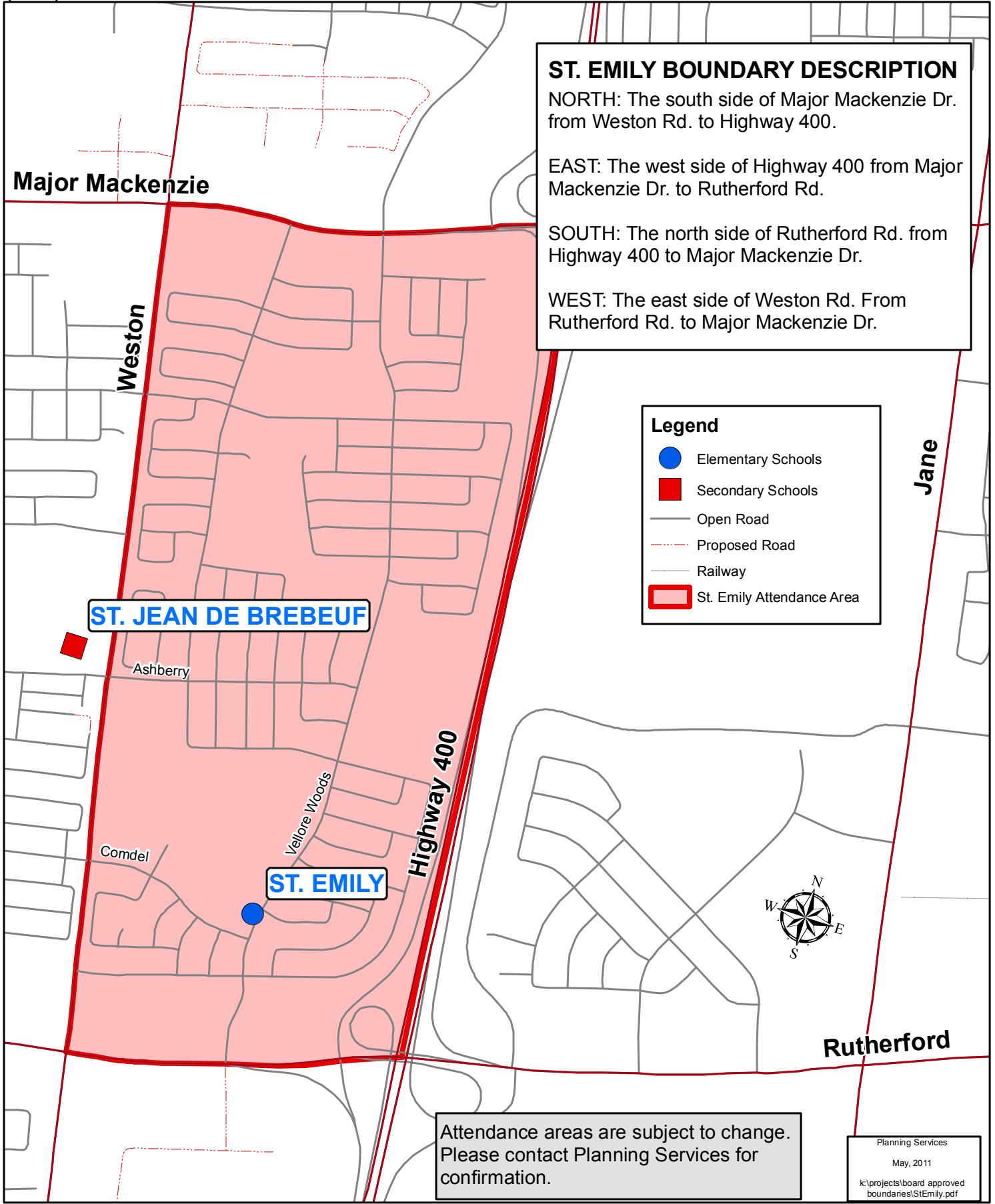

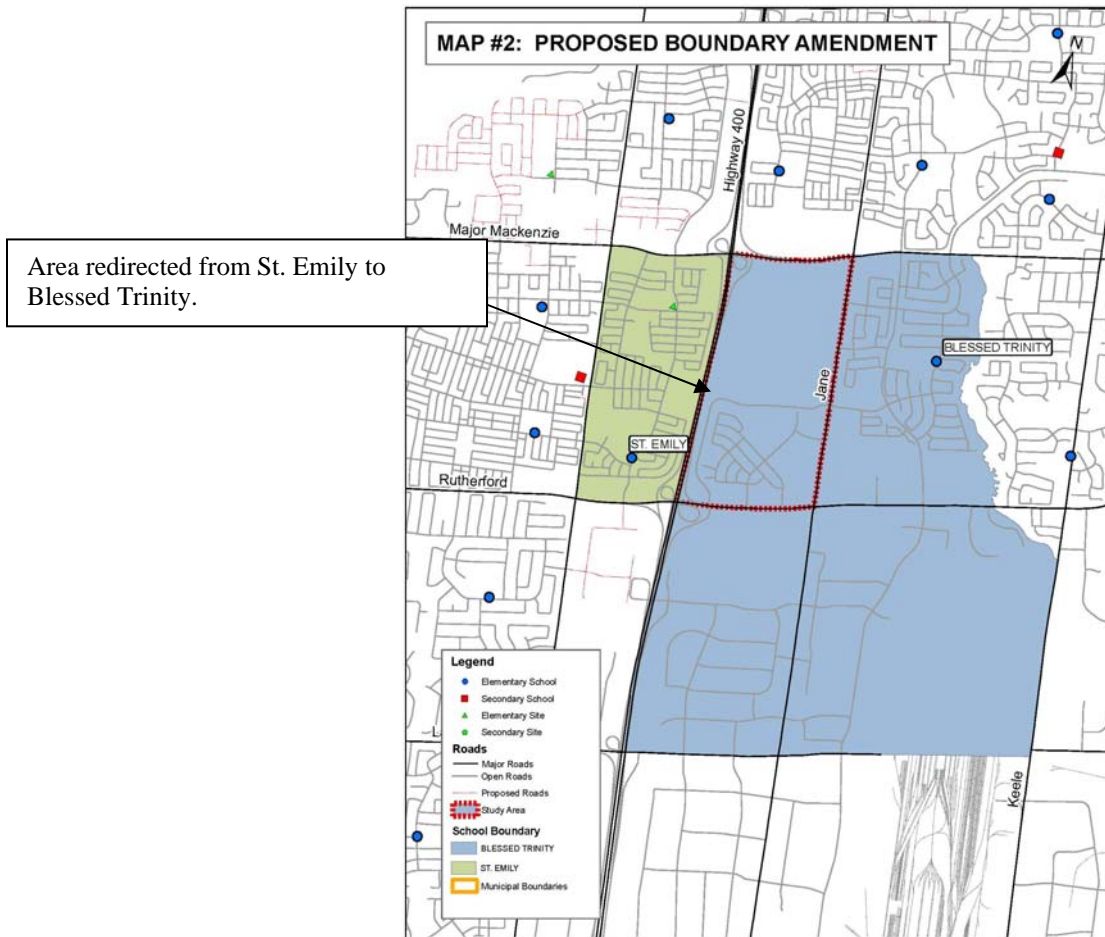

## **Board Approved Motions re: Boundary Amendment**

Meeting Date: May 17, 2011

1. **THAT** the Spring River community located East of Highway 400 be aligned with the Blessed Trinity boundary as described in Option 1 of the report dated April 1, 2011, effective immediately.
2. **THAT**, effective immediately, all new families are directed to Blessed Trinity;
3. **THAT**, until June 30, 2013, existing students residing within the study area have the option to attend either St. Emily or Blessed Trinity, with transportation;
4. **THAT**, as of September 2013, students within the study area will no longer be eligible for enrolment at St. Emily, with one exception. Those students enrolled in St. Emily as of April 12, 2011 in grades 4 and 5, with an older sibling attending St. Emily as of the same date, be given the option to continue to attend St. Emily, until graduation, without transportation.
5. **THAT** consistent with the secondary feeder school alignment for Blessed Trinity, all students within the redirected area be given the option to attend St. Elizabeth or St. Joan of Arc as of September, 2011.
6. **THAT**, effective September 1, 2013, St. Jean de Brebeuf CHS will no longer service the Spring River community as a secondary school.
