POLICY TITLE: PAYMENT OF TUITION FEES TO OTHER BOARDS

SECTION A

1. PURPOSE

The York Catholic District School Board recognizes its responsibility to provide education to all resident pupils of York Region who are eligible to attend its schools.

The Board also recognizes that some resident pupils may require exceptional/unique educational services not offered by the Board.

The purpose of this policy is to outline the guidelines whereby the York Catholic District School Board may enter into an agreement with another Board to provide exceptional/unique educational services for a pupil.

2. POLICY STATEMENT

It is the policy of the York Catholic District School Board, subject to Ontario Education Statutes and Regulations, to enter into an agreement with another Board to provide exceptional/unique educational services for a pupil where such services are not offered within the York Catholic District School Board.

3. PARAMETERS

- 3.1 Fees, if any, payable for the purposes under the regulations, may be paid to other school boards on behalf of resident pupils attending schools in other jurisdictions, under the following conditions:
- i) for those pupils identified as requiring a program and/or services not provided by the Board, or
 - ii) for those pupils who need a particular course or courses required as part of their credits for admission to university, or other post-secondary institution, or
 - iii) for those pupils in circumstances where required to do so under the Education Act.

- 3.2 Payment of fees, if any, under this policy will be applicable for those pupils who, in accordance with the Education Act, are identified as resident pupils of the York Catholic District School Board and
- i) the parent/guardian are separate school supporters in the jurisdiction of the York Catholic District School Board;
 - ii) the pupil is baptized Roman Catholic; and
 - iii) the parent/guardian ascertains that the receiving Board can provide placement for the pupil.
- 3.3 The agreement for payment of fees, if any, shall be limited to one school year and will be subject to review on a yearly basis.
- 3.4 Exceptions to the policy shall be made in accordance with the Ontario Education Act, Section 35 (1) (elementary) and 39(1) (secondary).
- 3.4 Transportation will not be provided.
