# Responsibilities of Catholic School Councils per Regulation

- Conduct yearly elections- within the first 30 days
- Hold a minimum of 4 meetings per year and abide by the Code of Ethics
- Hold meetings in school or location accessible to the public
- Keep minutes of the meetings
- All financial transactions must be recorded
- Publish an annual report- submit to principal & school board
- Consult with principal and parents on matters under consultation by the council
- May engage in fundraising activities according to Board policy

### **Catholic School Council Membership**

- Parents, minimum of 6, maximum of 15 (to be elected by parents)
- Parish Representative (appointed by Pastor)
- Community Representative (appointed by council)
- Non-teaching staff 1 (elected by non-teaching staff)
- Teacher Representative (elected by teachers)
- Principal (automatic member)

### **Procedures for Voting**

- Parents are invited to attend the candidates meeting and general election on Wednesday, September 25th, 2019
- Parents will vote for a maximum of 15 representatives by secret ballot
- A notice to all parent(s)/guardian(s) will announce the results
