They bloom during the Christmas season, and their star-shaped leaves call to mind both the star of Bethlehem and Christ himself who is called the "bright morning star." The poinsettia, which is native to Mexico, is called "Star Flower" in the language of the Aztec people. A charming legend spread throughout Mexico telling of how a simple weed was miraculously transformed into the first poinsettia plant on Christmas Eve.
