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Dear Potential Graduate:

You are cordially invited to participate in the St. Maximilian Kolbe Catholic High School Class of 2018 Graduation events and festivities. Please note the following:

- Graduation Mass and Luncheon will take place on **Wednesday, June 27th, 2018**. All graduates are required to attend the luncheon in order to pick up gown, tickets and other materials.
- Graduation Commencement will be held on **Thursday June 28th, 2018** at Le Parc Dining and Banquet Hall, 8432 Leslie St., in Thornhill, Ontario. Please note the start time of 6:00 pm.

Graduation Requirements:

In order to participate in the June 2018 Graduation Ceremony, graduates must satisfy all the requirements of the Ontario Secondary School Diploma including 40 Hours of Community Service hours and successful completion of the OSSLT (Literacy Test). **Community service hours must be completed and submitted by June 1st, 2018.**

Ceremony Information:

In order to participate in the ceremony, please submit a cheque in the amount of \$135, payable to *St. Maximilian Kolbe C.H.S.* to Ms. Benson in the main office by **Friday, March 9, 2018**. The fee will cover all related expenses including: the graduation lunch held the day prior, graduation gown, cap, stole and a 5 x 7 photo taken at the graduation ceremony.

The package fee will also include one program per graduate and one program per family plus 3 tickets to the ceremony. On Monday April 2nd, 2018 a limited amount of 2 additional tickets per graduate will be released for purchase on a first-come-first-serve basis in person in the main office. Tickets cannot be reserved and full cash/cheque payment is due upon purchase. Tickets may be purchased during lunch periods and after school only. Additional tickets may become available closer to the graduation date.

On the day of Graduation, students must check in at Le Parc by 5:15 p.m. At that time, doors will be opened to ticket holders and seating will be first come, first serve. Tickets will be required at Le Parc for admittance into the event, and will not be sold at the door. Graduates, please leave your purse and other personal belongings with a family member.

At this time, we would like to thank the Catholic School Council for helping to organize and subsidize the luncheon.
