



# Ash Wednesday Liturgy and Shrove Tuesday

Please join us for our **Ash Wednesday** Liturgy on Wednesday, March 6<sup>th</sup> at 10:45 am in the gym. All are welcome

We will celebrate **Shrove Tuesday** on March 5<sup>th</sup>, with a nut safe pancake treat for our students, hosted by our Catholic School Council. Information will be distributed home listing all ingredients. If you do not wish your child to participate in Pancake Tuesday, please contact your child's teacher directly. Thank you!

Lent is a time of year when Christian people begin their forty day journey toward Easter. During this time we reflect on our lives and repent for the ways in which we failed to fully live out the call of our Baptism. The word "lent" means springtime. It comes from the same root as "lengthen", since (at least in our northern hemisphere) the days begin to lengthen during the time in which we celebrate lent. In the natural world the long nights are giving way to longer days. The death of winter is turning toward the life of spring. In a similar way, Christians are turning from the darkness of sinful lives to the brightness of new life in Christ.

Shrove or Fat Tuesday: We begin preparing for our Lenten fast the day before Ash Wednesday. In many Christian cultures today, no meat (or meat products such as fat) is eaten for the whole forty days of Lent. Because of this, a custom developed to use up all the fat and meat before lent began. On the feast of Carnaval ("Meat Goes"), we say good-bye to meat. We fry up pancakes to use up all our fat. (Shrove or Pancake Tuesday). And so, we begin our fast with a feast.

Ash Wednesday: The ashes we use on Ash Wednesday come from the burning of the branches of palms blessed the year before on Palm Sunday. Ashes have been a symbol of repentance from Old Testament times. They remind us of our own mortality and our limitedness as creatures. Ashes remind us of how much we are in need of God's grace and mercy.

### **Black History Month**

The month of February is recognized throughout Canada as a time to celebrate the sacrifices and contributions of Black Canadians. Throughout February students will participate in a variety of discussions and grade-level lessons that focus on diversity and equality. Book displays will be set up in our library for students to explore and read and library lessons will focus on celebrating Black History Month. We look forward to these wonderful learning opportunities!

### **Weather Conditions**


