JK - Grade 8 (2019-2020)



- > The St. Mary of the Angels Catholic School Standardized Dress Code shall be worn to school each day
- > All articles of clothing shall be solid colours, as specified below
- Clothing shall be free of any writing, logos or pictures
- > Bottoms shall not include jeans, see through leggings/jeggings, and yoga pants
- > As per board policy, St. Mary of the Angels Spirit Wear items will be allowed as part of the Dress Code from JK-Gr.8

### TOPS:

- **COLOURS:** NAVY, WHITE, GREY, BABY BLUE SOLID COLOURS
  - Long or Short Sleeved Tops eg. Golf Shirts
  - Sweaters/ Layering Pieces and Spirit Wear Need To Be The Uniform Colours

### **BOTTOMS:**

- **COLOURS:** NAVY, BLACK, GREY SOLID COLOURS WITH NO CONTRASTING STRIPES
  - Cargo pants, Capris, Track Pants, Corduroy Pants, Bermuda Walking Shorts, Yoga
     Pants and Leggings with Appropriate Hip Length Tops or Tunics
- ✓ Also permitted are: skorts, (skirts with shorts), rompers, jumpers, golf shirt dresses



(However, logos that are the size of a loonie/toonie in size are permitted i.e. brand name or symbol)



The CSC Dress Code Committee has reviewed and approved the dress code and the expectation is that all students will be wearing the outlined articles every day to school.

# Parking & Kiss-and-Ride Safety

Parents and Guardians,

We are asking and reminding all parents and guardians to NOT park and/or leave your vehicle in the 'Kiss-And-Ride' during morning drop off. We are finding a number a vehicles unattended and parked, this is leading to increased levels of frustration and a backlog of vehicles trying to enter. We are asking respectfully, for everyone to work together and respect the rules of the Kiss-And-Ride. 'Kiss-And-Ride' Instructions: Please pull in (watch for children crossing), help your child(ren) out of the vehicle, say your 'goodbyes/kiss' them off and exit the Kiss-And-Ride. Please do not linger or leave your car unattended. If parents/guardians wish to walk and continue supporting their child's entry, we encourage that they safely park on the city street and walk over. Thank you in advance for your cooperation and support in ensuring the safety for all during the busy morning drop off.

End of day procedures: The school parking lot is closed at 2:30. Entry after this time is prohibited for the following reasons;

- After school daycare staff require parking.
- Parents with appointments with teacher/administration require parking.
- Fire route must not be blocked.
- Vehicle traffic in the parking lot and 'Kiss-And-Ride' area leads to unsafe conditions and puts student safety at risk.

Publish an annual report – submit to Principal & Board. Consult with parents on matters under consultation by the council.

May engage in fund raising activities in accordance with School Board Policy.

# Catholic School Council Membership must include:

Parents, minimum 10, maximum 20 (to be elected by parents)

Community Representative (appointed by Council) Non-teaching staff 1 (elected by non-teaching staff)

Teacher 1 (elected by teachers)

Principal (automatic member)
