French Immersion programs are designed to provide non-francophone children with a high level of proficiency in the French language. While any exposure to a second language is beneficial, French Immersion offers students a broader and deeper learning experience.

In addition to its excellent English program, **Christ the King CES** offers an **Early French Immersion Program**.

A **Parent Information Night** will be held on **Thursday, November 27, 2025**, to provide details about the Grade 1 French Immersion Program.

The **online application process** for students entering **Grade 1 in September 2026** will open on **Friday, November 28, 2025**. Families will be able to access the **online application** following the presentation at <https://www.ycdsb.ca/frenchimmersion>

Transportation will be provided to French Immersion Students living within the Christ the King CES French Immersion Boundary.

- Students in grades 1 to grades 3, residing 1.2 km beyond the school and within the FI boundary will receive transportation.
- Students in grades 4 to grades 8, who live beyond 1.6 km and live within the French Immersion transportation boundary will receive transportation.
