
In addition to its excellent English program, *St. Elizabeth Seton CES* offers an **Early French Immersion Program**.

A **Parent Information Night** will be held on **Thursday, November 13, 2025**, to introduce families to the Grade 1 French Immersion Program.

Transportation will be provided to French Immersion Students living within the St. Elizabeth Seton CES French Immersion Boundary.

- Students in grades 1 to grades 3, residing 1.2 km beyond the school and within the FI boundary will receive transportation.
- Students in grades 4 to grades 8, who live beyond 1.6 km and live within the French Immersion transportation boundary will receive transportation.
- \* Students are required to walk a short distance to and from centralized bus stops
