<b>Specific Statement of Issue</b> The York Catholic District School Board (YCDSB) is the only Catholic school board in the GTA that is not flying the Pride flag. This may reflect the level of inclusion for 2SLGBTQIA+ students in the YCDSB, that the YCDSB has yet to act on such a simple but important way to show its efforts towards inclusion. The Fully Alive textbook would be deemed to be teaching homophobia and transphobia if used in a York Region District School Board (YRDSB). The harm of this textbook in the YRDSB does not somehow become harmless because it is used in the YCDSB, a Catholic board. The harm of this textbook towards, especially towards 2SLGBTQIA+ students, should lead the YCDSB to no longer make it available as a learning resource in its elementary schools.	
<b>If Applicable, your key recommendations/suggestions to address the problem/issue:</b> 1. The YCDSB should fly the Pride flag every June, starting in June 2023, at all YCDSB schools. 2. The YCDSB should no longer make available Fully Alive as a learning resource in YCDSB elementary schools. 3. The YCDSB should move towards other 2SLGBTQIA+ inclusion improvements (such as related training for its educators).
