#### 4.0 DIRECTOR'S REPORT

Superintendent of Education Di Nardo delivered the Director's Report on behalf of the Director Preston.

Good evening everyone. Our Director had a previous commitment this evening and she sends her regrets and has asked me to share a few words on her behalf.

Welcome and Happy New Year! I hope that you enjoyed a wonderful Christmas and time to relax with family and friends.

#### Parent Concerns regarding Icy School Yard Conditions

We know that the last week was a bit of a challenge across the system with icy conditions in our school playgrounds and I wanted to address this with you, as we aware of parent concerns regarding the icy conditions in school playgrounds.

As you know, the Board has revised its Winter Maintenance Practice with respect to plowing the playground area. This new procedure aligns with the long-standing winter maintenance practices at many other school boards across the province. The YRDSB has maintained this practice since 2004.

Last week, the fluctuating temperatures and the timing of precipitation created challenging conditions. Over the weekend, contractors for the York Catholic District School Board applied salt to all playgrounds to relieve the icy conditions.

The safety and well-being of all students are our top priority, and when it is deemed to be safe, children will be allowed to play out on the school yard. We follow the Board's Inclement Weather Procedures for indoor routine. We recognize that children need an opportunity to get exercise and free play time outdoors, however, weather conditions sometimes warrant indoor routines or a reduced activity level outdoors. Conditions requiring changes in normal practice are: rain, freezing rain, thunderstorms, lightning, hail, ice, and extreme winds - these conditions require indoor routines.

#### **Board Inaugural**

I would like to take a moment to congratulate our new Chair and Vice Chair of the Board. The Board held its Board Inaugural Meeting on December 1<sup>st</sup>, 2016. His Excellency, Bishop Wayne Kirkpatrick celebrated a beautiful mass to start the evening. Our Trustees took the Oath of Office and we elected our Chair and Vice-Chair of the Board. I would like to congratulate Carol Cotton who was re-elected Chair of the Board and Elizabeth Crowe who was re-elected as our Vice-Chair. Carol, Elizabeth, and all of our trustees are committed to putting the needs of our students and families first. An election by ballot was not held as both Trustees Cotton and Crowe were acclaimed to their positions. The unanimous decision is a testament to the Board of Trustees' unified vision for Catholic Education in York Region.

#### **Funds Raised**

Our schools have raised \$45,112.80 for earthquake victims in Italy this year. This amount has been donated to the Archdiocese of Toronto's Vatican Relief Agency, Caritas Canada. Throughout the months of November and December, our schools also collected funds for humanitarian relief in Haiti following the damage caused by Hurricane Matthew; another \$16,655 was raised Board-wide. These donations are being channeled

through the Archdiocese to Caritas Canada. This is just a snapshot of some of our larger, system-wide fundraising efforts, and I thank you, our parents, for your contributions to these worthy causes.

One of the many joys in the role as Director of Education is visiting our schools. This is a wonderful opportunity to see the excellent work taking place by our students and staff, and to speak with our dedicated administrators. # **Pastoral Zone Meeting**

On November 2<sup>nd</sup>, the Board welcomed all of our Parish Priests for our annual Pastoral Zone Meeting at the CEC. The feedback received from our parish priests was very positive. A presentation was shared by our Religious Education Coordinator and Consultants on the Elementary Religion Education Program and the Secondary Religious Education policy document. #### **Mental Health**

Mental Health and well-being continues to be a top priority for our Board. Our Mental Health Team is planning our annual Student Mental Health Symposium for the spring. All elementary and secondary schools are invited to participate and the events will be held here at the CEC. The theme for this conference is "Be Empowered."

# The conference goals are to:

- Promote and heighten awareness and understanding of mental health in the school and the community;
- Increase mental health literacy and provide the skills and knowledge to recognize the signs and symptoms of mental health and appropriate resources;
- Increase the student skills to promote coping skills for a healthy lifestyle;
- Decrease the stigma associated with mental health.

# Kindergarten Registration

Finally, Kindergarten registration has begun for September 2017. Families can register at their local Catholic school. All of our schools now offer the Full-Day Kindergarten Program. We encourage you to share the news about our Kindergarten Registration with parents in your community. We are looking forward to welcoming new families in September.
