Specific Statement of Issue

Pope Francis CS boundary review decision has resulted in severe implications for my 3.5 year old son & our family. Our biggest concern is the mental health consequence from the boards decision that rejected him and has now separated and isolated him from our community and friends.

We are residents of Zone A since 2014 and see the school from our house. As a result of this rezoning process, our son has been separated from his peers, our two children have been forced into separate learning institutions and our family had been isolated from the community we live in.

Summary of key presentation points:

1. Current decision does not address and resolve the capacity issue

Based on many conversations with employees of the board and our trustee we have been advised that the school will require another boundary review next year or the following year because the current decision does not address the capacity issues. This a short sighted decision and could prove to be even ore detrimental to current and future students mental health.

2. My son has been isolated and separated from his friends and community

My son has attended Pope Francis daycare since 2019 and as a result of COVID this is all he knows as school. We have been told he is one of few children who did not get accepted to Pope Francis CS, when every single one of his friends at daycare have been accepted. The mental consequence this has on my child is severe and the impact will effect him in years to come. In additional my youngest son will be attending this daycare next month - we have been on a waitlist for 2 years and now my family is being separated.

3. My sons citizenship

My son has been a citizen of this neighbourhood every second of his life. in every community, organization, country, citizenship holds the ultimate honour and value, especially when a decision is being made that related to priorities. We strongly contend that the board have overlooked this significant honour and standing. A citizen of a neighbourhood should never be discriminated from enjoying the privileges of their neighbourhood to allow a non-citizen to take his place. This is unfair and unjust.

We are seeking your compassionate and empathetic consideration for an accommodation to allow our son to attend Pope Francis in September 2022.
