Whereas the YCDSB recognizes the value of STREAM (Science, Technology, Religion, Engineering, Arts and Math) education for students; Whereas the YCDSB is committed to the equitable delivery of STREAM learning opportunities to students; Whereas ensuring that exceptional students have appropriate supports for off-site learning, including familiar surroundings and routines, may inadvertently create barriers for some classes and/or schools to fully participate in STREAM education experiences; Whereas timing constraints on STREAM visits are a natural result of transportation scheduling limitations; Whereas the cost of transportation for students to attend STREAM centres is funded centrally. LET IT BE RESOLVED: THAT staff investigate whether there may be efficiencies in transitioning to mobile STREAM centres where teachers are itinerant and hard goods are transported to the host school; THAT the report includes recommendations on increasing access to STREAM learning for exceptional students. This Motion will be an Information Item on the October 28, 2025 Regular Board Agenda.
TRUSTEE MOTION: Request for an In-Camera Meeting with OCSTA and Provincial Trustees (A. Saggese, M. lafrate) Whereas the Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association (OCSTA) serves as the provincial voice for Ontario's 29 English Catholic school boards, advocating for publicly funded Catholic education to the provincial government; Whereas the OCSTA promotes and protects the Catholic school system by representing the interests of Catholic school boards on matters of education policy, governance, and funding, while providing professional services and resources to trustees across the province; Whereas the OCSTA functions as the central representative body for all 29 English Catholic District School Boards in Ontario; Whereas a negative and often inaccurate narrative regarding the role of school trustees has recently been portrayed in the media, overshadowing the important and positive contributions made by trustees to publicly funded education; LET IT BE RESOLVED THAT the Ontario Catholic School Trustees' Association be requested to convene an in-camera meeting with all provincial school trustees to engage in a strategic discussion on how to collectively change the public narrative and ensure greater awareness of the good work being done by trustees in support of publicly funded education; THAT trustees across the province collaboratively explore ways to modernize and strengthen the role of trustees, ensuring continued relevance, transparency, and alignment with the mission of publicly funded education.
