EQAO published its secondary school results recently, and we are very pleased to announce that 89 percent of our students, who are enrolled in Grade 9 Academic Math, achieved the provincial standard. This is an increase from last year, where we were at 86 percent. Math instruction continues to be a focus for our board, and it is wonderful to see improvement in our scores.
