Early Intervention Services (EIS)

EIS is in the process of discussing the transition to school process with families entering the YCDSB in the Fall of 2020 to help ensure a smooth transition from EIS to the YCDSB. This process includes describing to families school options, classroom expectations, and details to complete a notification to the YCDSB. Families in the new year are encouraged to attend a YCDSB parent information evening to learn more about the Board. In late winter, families attend Early Facilitation visits so that school staff see and hear about service needs and in early spring, families attend transition to school meetings when they describe their child's strengths, needs, and strategies with school staff. Before school begins, the family is encouraged to share a full report from EIS, which includes a summary of services, their child's strengths & needs, and helpful strategies.
