New School Boundary Required

Local Boundary Review Committee (LBRC) Established

<u>Consists of:</u> Local trustee(s), school superintendent(s), principal(s), Planning Services staff, Student Transportation Services staff and New Construction staff (If New School)

LBRC Meeting(s)

Objective: To review preliminary boundary information including enrolment figures, development information, preliminary boundary options and other information specific to the school communities. More than one LBRC meeting may be held prior to meeting with Catholic School Council chairs.

Catholic School Council Meeting

Objective: To introduce the boundary review process to the Catholic School Council Chairs; to review boundary information including enrolment projections, development information, boundary options and other information specific to the school community; to review any questions/concerns specific to the school community

Public Information Session

Objective: To introduce the boundary review process to the school community; To present proposed boundary options in a 'drop in' style meeting format; To provide a forum for families to ask questions pertaining to the boundary review process and proposed options;

Boundary Review Process Planning Goals

To establish a school attendance area, the following must be considered:

- 1. Ensure appropriate accommodation for all students
- 2. Minimize unnecessary bussing
- 3. Identify physical barriers to school access (ie. major roads, railway tracks, hydro corridors, rivers, etc.)
- 4. Minimize boundary changes for growing areas
- 5. Maximize the use of all permanent school facilities to minimize portable placement




Background Information

- Our Lady of Good Counsel founded in 1959, relocated to Murrell Drive in 2017
- Good Shepherd opened in 1993
- Continued residential growth throughout the municipality
- Continued enrolment pressures
 - 4 portables at Good Shepherd
 - 6 portables at Our Lady of Good Counsel
- Funding approval for a school in Queensville
 - Construction commenced July 2025
 - Anticipated Opening: September 2027




Background Information Unnamed Queensville ES - Location Map






Current Situation / Study Area Map







Residential Development Areas





Current Situation – Enrolment Projections









Option 1 - Proposed Boundary Alignment






Option 1 - Enrolment Projections












Option 2 - Proposed Boundary Alignment






Option 2 - Enrolment Projections












Option 3 - Proposed Boundary Alignment






Option 3 - Enrolment Projections

 Students may be eligible for transportation if their primary address is located within their home school attendance area and is further than the following distances:


Grades JK-3	1.2 km
Grades 4-8	1.6 km





Secondary Boundary Alignment
