1.0 WELCOME/PRAYER

Chair Ms. Psaila welcomed and thanked everyone for being present. Introduction followed. Chair then requested those present for intentions. All said the prayer included in our handouts.

2.0 CALL TO ORDER

Lead by Director Ms. Preston.

3.0 <u>DIRECTOR'S REMARKS</u>

Good evening everyone. Welcome to our first meeting of the 2017/2018 school year. I hope you all had an enjoyable and restful summer with family and friends. The month of September has flown by, and we are off to a great school start. In addition to the

traditional school events that reflect a new school year, our schools have also begun some excellent work in the area of charity -- many schools have hosted their annual Terry Fox Runs, and as Thanksgiving season draws near, our schools are participating in a special Thanksgiving Food Drive called "One for Haiti" where all students and staff will be asked to donate one food item for the people of Haiti. In July, we had an opportunity to meet with Father Brian Kerr, who is the Director for an organization called *Missionaries of the Poor*. We have partnered with Fr. Brian and we will be inviting all schools to participate in a food drive for this worthy initiative.

Share Life

This summer, we also got some great news from ShareLife --York Catholic schools raised \$133,446.14, which is an increase over the previous year by 13.44%. This is wonderful news and I thank our parents and schools communities for supporting ShareLife year after year.

Safety Awareness Week

Schools across the system will participate in Safety Awareness Week this week. All schools are practicing various drills and procedures for emergency preparedness and safety awareness. The safety of our students and staff safe is a top priority, and we are dedicated to creating a safe learning environment for all students and staff.

EOAO Results

EQAO has released the results of the Grade 3, 6 and 9 assessments and according to the results from EQAO and the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test, York Catholic students continue to outpace their provincial peers in most areas of testing.

Reading and writing continue to be our strongest areas. The EQAO results by school are listed on our website. Please visit our website for additional details by school.

There is always more work to be done as we strive to improve our students' outcomes; and this year, as with the rest of the province, we will make math the priority. Our curriculum team is working with the Ministry's Renewed Math Strategy so that all students are provided with 60 minutes of math instruction per day.

<u>Ministry Of Education – Announcement of Key Initiatives</u>

Each year, the Ministry of Education announces its Key Initiatives for the school year. The Minister of Education and the Premier announced the government's next steps in the areas of well-being and equity to meet the objectives of its "Achieving Excellence" strategy for education in Ontario.

The focus areas include:

Well-Being Strategy – will include the effects that bullying and mental health have on student success in and out of the classroom.

Updated Curriculum and New Report Cards – which will include a comprehensive review, as well as a public consultation on the province's Kindergarten to grade 12 Curriculum. The goal is to improve student achievement in core skills such as math and increase the emphasis on transferrable life skills such as Communication, Problem

Solving, Critical Thinking and Global Citizenship. Beginning next school year, a **new Report Card** will be introduced to better track a student's development in these skills.

Ontario's Education Equity Action Plan – This plan will serve as the province's blueprint for identifying and eliminating discriminatory practices, systemic barriers and biases from schools and classrooms.

Land Acknowledgment

School Boards across Ontario are demonstrating their commitment to Truth and Reconciliation by providing Land Acknowledgements that honour Indigenous Peoples and traditional lands. At YCDSB, we echo the Canadian Conference of Catholic Bishops (CCCB) and the Assembly of Catholic Bishops of Ontario (ACBO) in their response to the Calls to Action through the Truth and Reconciliation Commission.

YCDSB's First Nations, Métis and Inuit Steering Committee (Indigenous Elders and YCDSB Board and school staff) in consultation with Trustees and Senior Administration developed a Land Acknowledgement Statement. This statement is inclusive of all Indigenous Peoples and it will be embedded as a distinct school practice and will be recited at all large school community of gatherings.

It reads:

We are gathered on the ancestral lands and waters of all Indigenous Peoples, who have left their footprints on Mother Earth before us.

We respectfully acknowledge those who have walked on it, those who walk on it now, and future generations who have yet to walk upon it.

We pray to the Creator for strength and wisdom that all may continue to serve as stewards of the Earth.
