In addition to the traditional school events that reflect a new school year, our schools have also begun some excellent work in the area of charity -- many schools have hosted their annual Terry Fox Runs, our schools are participating in the Italy Earthquake Fundraising Campaign with the Archdiocese. As the Thanksgiving season draws near, we will see many of our schools preparing for food drives and other charitable activities to demonstrate gratitude. I thank all of our school communities: the staff, students and especially our parents for supporting these worthy initiatives.

Multi Year Strategic Plan

As you know, in 2014, the Board unveiled a Multi-Year Strategic Plan. Last February, we shared a survey with all of stakeholders, including all parents, to assess your awareness of the Strategic Plan. Parents were our largest respondent group and I thank the many parents who took part in our Awareness Survey last February. Your feedback helps to shape the Board's yearly goals of the plan. This year we are implementing the *Year 2* goals of the Strategic Plan and I encourage you to visit our website at the end of this month where will share an Annual Report on our work to date to achieve our goals.

Safety Awareness Week

Schools across the system are currently participating in Safety Awareness Week. All schools are practicing various drills and procedures for emergency preparedness and safety awareness. The safety of our students and staff safe is a top priority, and we are dedicated to creating a safe learning environment for all students and staff.

EQAO Results

EQAO has released the results of the Grade 3, 6 and 9 assessments and according to the results from EQAO and the Ontario Secondary School Literacy Test, York Catholic students continue to outpace their provincial peers in most areas of testing.

Reading and writing continue to be our strongest areas. We also achieved great results in the Grade 9 Academic Math Assessment with 86%.

There is always more work to be done as we strive to improve our students' outcomes; and this year, as with the rest of the province, we will make math the priority. Our

curriculum team is working with the Ministry's Renewed Math Strategy so that all students are provided with 60 minutes of math instruction per day.

Summer Highlights from across the YCDSB

It was a very busy summer for YCDSB staff and I would like to share with you just a couple of highlights:

Construction over the Summer

I wanted to share with your some of our summer highlights as well. This summer, our facilities and construction staff worked very hard to complete our newest school, Pope Francis Catholic Elementary School in Kleinburg. We had a great school opening on the first day of school.

Also this summer, over 75 construction and facility renewal projects took place in our schools to get classrooms and school yards ready for back to school. At the elementary level, we continued with classroom retrofits for the implementation of Full-Day Kindergarten. New FDK classrooms will open at St. Mark, St. Thomas Aquinas and Our Lady of Fatima. Other work included: roof, fire alarm and stair replacements, painting, school yard ground repairs and more.

Admissions

Once again, our Board accepted new student registrations for the elementary panel over the summer. Our admissions department indicated that 149 new registrations were received this summer. This is terrific news, and we will continue the practice of accepting new student registrations next summer. We also saw an increase in the number of VISA students joining York Catholic and this too, is wonderful news.
